PROJECT OVERVIEW

Part of the Anglian Multi-Academy Trust, the newly-built Marleigh Primary Academy needed an experienced furniture company to design and fit out its entire school including multiple classrooms, office spaces, and a learning hub. PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Wall Pockets have been a fantastic addition to this village school. With a small hall and limited space, the Wall Pockets allow the school to easily transform the space into a versatile area for learning and a space for dining according to their needs.

Westcountry Group installed three single customised Wall Pocket dining systems in their multi-use hall, delivering seating for up to 60 students. The school chose a unique colour for the Wall Pocket case to match the school's colour scheme.

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Due to an increased demand for science facilities within the school, New Hall commissioned us to transform an under-utilised space into a high-tech science laboratory.

Hazlegrove Prep School boarders have been celebrating the newly refreshed junior boys' house, which has undergone an extensive refurbishment.

Westcountry Group were tasked with creating a welcoming, relaxing, and practical space for the students to enjoy as well as a space that was durable enough to withstand extensive daily use.

Our expert design team carefully designed each room to reflect the delicate balance between home and school. We installed low lighting, comfy seating, and quiet areas in the common room; colourful soft furnishings, cloud-shaped lights, and bean bags for the Lego room; comfortable and durable bedroom furniture for the dorms; and refurbished bathrooms.

PROJECT STEM Rooms Refurbishment Project | LOCATION Hampton, Middlesex



PROJECT OVERVIEW

Westcountry Group worked closely with the school to create a new, state-of-the-art 'Engine Room', which offers a flexible and practical place for students to learn.

The main objective for the refurbishment work at Hampton Prep School was to increase and foster a more interactive, engaging, and collaborative approach to learning, building student interest in STEM-related areas.

Movable tables and stools were installed offering flexible seating configurations that cater to a range of lesson styles from individual workstations to group work. New storage units were installed to provide greater ease of access to materials, apparatus, and equipment.

The new facilities will make learning more fun for students, allowing them to improve their problem-solving, creative thinking, and critical analysis — essential skills for them to achieve success at school and in the future.



CLAIRES COURT SCHOOL

PROJECT Jubilee Building Furniture | LOCATION Maidenhead, Berkshire



PROJECT OVERVIEW

Westcountry Group were delighted to be chosen to renovate the school's new Jubilee wing. This project consisted of a newly refurbished suite of classrooms with interactive teaching walls and an atrium breakout area.

We created a bright and contemporary design complete with inspirational quotes and graphics on the walls. Themed according to subject, the geography rooms now display a large physical map of the world for easy teaching reference alongside quotes from Shakespeare and Maya Angelou for inspiration in the English classes. Each of the six classrooms is equipped with whiteboard tables that can be written on and arranged to suit the style of teaching required.

The refurbishment also includes a social workspace in the atrium, divided into smaller pods promoting collaborative study and social interaction and an impressive floor-to-ceiling feature wall.

PROJECT Learning Hub Refurbishment | **LOCATION** Battersea, South London



PROJECT OVERVIEW

Learning hubs have become increasingly popular within educational establishments. They provide a space where learning can be tailored to individual needs and where teaching can be adapted to respond to the children's interests and abilities.

Westcountry Group were tasked to create a unique space that provides a collaborative, stimulating, and engaging learning environment that encourages creative thinking and problem-solving.

To make the new learning hub fun and engaging, our talented interior design team suggested incorporating a nature-inspired design. We introduced a forest-themed feature wall, an interactive teaching wall, and other nature-inspired elements including floor-standing acoustics shaped like trees and leaves, colour-coordinated furniture, carpet tiles, and bird-shaped lighting.

The new interactive space now provides a sense of togetherness and has created a fun learning area for the children to engage in small group work and individual activities.

PROJECT OVERVIEW

PROJECT Higher Education Centre Refurbishment | **LOCATION** Plymouth, Devon



PROJECT OVERVIEW

As part of their commitment to providing students with top-class learning environments, City College Plymouth engaged Westcountry Group to revamp their higher education centre. The college wanted to create an inspiring space that would appeal to their students and provide them with an agile area to work and collaborate.

We combined two separate rooms and utilised a corridor area to create a fresh, modern, and vibrant open-plan space with multiple zones and two study rooms to suit different styles of working. The area was populated with a variety of learning space styles and furniture to give students a choice of where and how to work.

We installed furniture finished in bright materials, providing pockets of space for group work, fitted benching and seating against the perimeter of the room, creating study space and room for laptops and booth seating for informal meetings before or after lectures and for relaxing.

The feedback has been incredibly positive, with emphasis on the pleasing aesthetics and bright colours, and most importantly, how a previously unutilised space is now being used to its fullest potential.



WESTMINSTER CITY SCHOOL

PROJECT Sixth Form Centre Rooms | LOCATION Westminster, London



PROJECT OVERVIEW

The existing sixth-form common rooms at Westminster City School needed a revamp. The school wanted to transform its existing facilities into a more usable, bright, and modern area for their students to relax, study, and socialise in.

Our approach was a modern and contemporary design. The space has been divided into more usable zones, providing students with an adaptable area to use their time in between lessons as they wish.

To complete the look, we provided seating areas with comfortable, colourful, and robust furniture for the students to sit and study. Additionally, we installed booth areas for independent study.

The renovations to the sixth-form common rooms have created a tranquil hub where workstations sit alongside hang-out zones, creating a calm environment for individual work, collaboration, and socialising.

PROJECT OVERVIEW

School libraries have a vital role to play throughout the learning journey, in supporting literacy, health, and well-being, and improving attainment.

Nanpean School's existing library was looking tired. The school enlisted the help of Westcountry Group to transform this area, maximising the use of available space. Their vision was to create a calm, engaging, and inviting place for the children to enjoy books.
